YARD WASTE

Tree limbs and brush is picked up on Mondays, January through September, limbs should be set at curb side after 7:00 PM Sunday night. Limbs should be laid in same direction and no larger than five inches thick. Leaves, grass clippings and other yard waste are collected with the normal garbage pickup.

TRUCK RENTALS

Overnight trucks are available to rent to facilitate in disposing of a large volume of refuse. Trucks are dropped off on the day of reservation by 3:00 PM and picked up the following morning. Please check with the administrative office for availability and pricing. Owner occupied residential properties receive one free truck rental annually.

RECYCLING

Recycling is available to all Lockland residents at no additional cost. All households have received a red 18-gallon recycling bin. Recycling is collected the same day as your trash, by a separate truck. Residents can upgrade to a 65-gallon recycling cart, at no additional cost. Contact Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 to request a cart. Recycling drop off centers are also located on North Cooper Avenue and Mill Street.
