GARBAGE PICKUP

Be sure to set your garbage out after 7 PM the evening before your normal pickup and set your cans back in a timely manner. If your garbage or recycling isn't collected, please contact Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 or visit rumpke.com.

COMPOST BIN SALE

Hamilton County Recycling and Solid Waste District is having a compost bin sale on August 10 from 9 AM-1 PM at St. Xavier High School. Additional information is available online through hamiltoncountyrecycles.org or on the Village website.

TREE LIMBS AND BRUSH

Tree limbs and brush should be set out to the curb on Sunday evening after 7 PM. The chipper truck runs on Mondays. Please place limbs facing the same direction. Clippings should be set out with your normal garbage.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

Please keep your lawns cut and sidewalks and curb lines weed free. Grass over 8 inches high is in violation and will be cited. Do not blow clippings into the street. If you plan on doing any repairs or additions, please contact Chris Pitch-Code Enforcement Officer at 761-1124 x120. He can issue a zoning certificate at no cost. Permits are handled through Hamilton County.

WATER CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT

MSD CUSTOMER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati (MSD) offers a Customer Assistance Program (CAP) to help low-income senior citizens pay their sewer bills. If you meet the MSD CAP eligibility requirements, you will receive a 25% discount on your monthly sewer charges. The estimated annual savings for a MSD senior customer is \$120 (or more) per year. Eligibility is based on age, income, and property ownership. Application forms are available online at locklandoh.org or at Town Hall during normal business hours

WATER/UTILITY BILLS

Water/Utility bills go out the beginning of every odd month and are typically due the last billing day of that month. If you purchased a property, you will need to put the account into your name. This requires you to submit a water contract to the administrative office and put down a deposit. Rental properties require the owner's approval. Bills can be paid in the office during normal business hours, the overnight box is available after hours, or pay online at locklandoh.org. For additional details, please contact the administrative office.
